This patient's hearing was screened using otoacoustic emissions. The patient **passed** the hearing screening in both ears, which indicates that hearing is adequate for normal speech and language development. No further testing is recommended at this time.

A delayed onset hearing loss can develop and this screening does not rule out the need for future evaluation if parental concerns regarding speech and language development arise or if future medical events place this child at risk for a hearing loss. The Joint Committee on Infant Hearing advises that follow-up hearing evaluations occur if this patient has a congenital infection, or a family history of hearing loss.
