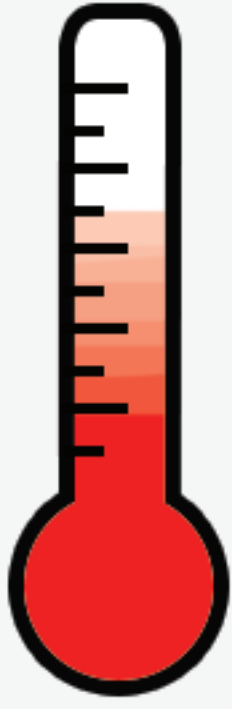


Did you KNOW?

When an eclipse occurs, some animals think they day has ended. For example, bats start to come out of their caves and crickets start to chirp. When the sunlight returns after an eclipse, some roosters may even start to sing!

Other **PLANETS** have eclipses, too!

Jupiter has

79 moons,

so it has the **most frequent** number of eclipses.

The **shadow**

of a solar eclipse can travel at speeds of more than

5,000

kilometers

(over 3,000 miles) per hour!
