Quick Tips to Consider

Make sure emergency equipment is accessible

ASK YOUR TEAM: Where are your AEDs, first aid kits. and evacuation chairs?

ASK YOUR TEAM: If equipment is in a locked room,

who has the key?

ASK YOUR TEAM: Do you have equipment for

those with special needs?

Make sure students and staff are trained on adult and infant CPR and AED usage.

ASK YOUR TEAM: Can you help provide CPR and AED training to your facility?

Know how to treat severe emergencies

ASK YOUR TEAM: Do you know how to treat anaphylaxis, severe bleeding, or overdose?

Perform regular equipment inspections

ASK YOUR TEAM: Have we checked AEDs, first aid kits, disinfectants, and other emergency equipment?
