Monthly fire drills with students and staff so that everyone knows all evacuation procedures



Working exterior lighting with timers or motion sensing capabilities



Working intrusion alarms, ventilator openings, and roof hatches



Proper equipment for fire prevention, evacuation and fire treatment

School fires mostly start in bathrooms or locker rooms.



Schools should make sure fire alarms, fire extinguishers, cooking equipment, water-based protection systems, and sprinklers are fully functional.



From 2014-2018 fire departments responded to an average of 3,230 structure fires in schools per year.
